IMPORTANT INFORMATION from MASS GENERAL BRIGHAM BROADCAST

Recovery of Educational Activities

Mass General Brigham remains committed to our educational mission and will begin to resume student clinical activities in a phased approach. The Mass General Brigham Education Recovery Workgroup has released guidelines for educational activities through the summer and fall.

On-site educational activities not required as part of a degree-granting program and not required to be conducted in the clinical setting will continue to be limited, suspended and/or conducted virtually. This includes:

- Staff training and continuing education activities (such as simulation sessions, inservices, training and testing center activities and continuing professional development post-graduate courses) will be limited, until at least September 1, to in-person sessions for groups of 10 people or less and limited to Mass General Brigham users only. All other staff training and continuing education programs must be suspended or conducted virtually.
- External visitors who are not part of existing educational affiliation agreements will be suspended until at least September 1. Visiting medical students will be suspended until at least October 1, consistent with the policies of our medical school affiliates.
- Non-direct care learning (such as conferences, grand rounds, M&Ms and didactic sessions) will continue virtually. Until at least December 31, all inperson programs will be suspended.
- Observership visits and programs (not required as part of a degree-granting program) will be suspended until at least December 31.
